St. Wilfred's College for Girls' Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organized **Two Days** International Conference on "Emerging Patterns of Development: Global Scenario" in with Collaboration Savitribai Phule organization for Academic Research & Social development, Jaipur from 2nd January -3rd January, 2023. Of Zoology, UOR Jaipur, Guest of Honor Prof. Gopal Dixit Dept. of Botany, MJP, Bareily. Dr. Keshav Badaya Hon. Secretary, St. Wilfred's Education Society and Dr. Manisha Tiwari Principal, St. Wilfred's College for Girls felicitated all the guests with shawl, saafa and Memento. Learned delegates, researches and scholars from various states attended the seminar. Various themes of biodiversity its conservation, sustainable development and new research areas were discussed in detail. More than 100 participants presented their research papers and best papers were awarded. The seminar

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was turned out to be a successful event and head of the institutions appreciated the efforts of college staffs.

- One-day Seminar on Molecular Biology was organized for students of Dept. of Zoology on 12th December 2022. 
